

- Tranquil colors
- Comfy furniture
- Positive, inspirational messages
- Journals, coloring books and other sensory objects

Having a therapeutic environment to self-regulate allows students to enter the classroom feeling more calm, relaxed, confident, and grounded.



Application Guidelines

Please provide:

- Explanation of how your school's students will benefit from a Calming Room
- Application completed and submitted by an adult staff member of the school – principal, teacher, counselor, nurse, etc.
- An explanation of how you plan to make the Calming Room a success
- A description of the space in the school you will use to create a Calming Room – verify location
- An explanation of who will be responsible for maintaining/monitoring the room
- An explanation of how you plan to spend the \$2,500 to create the Calming Room (include paint, fixtures, furniture, accessories, etc.)
- Information about whether your school will have a budget to maintain and enhance the Calming Room going forward
- Contact information of a staff member to communicate with Arkansas Blue Cross representatives for PR purposes, including room dedication, Calming Room progress, etc.
- Confirmation of willingness to submit progress pictures of room development, pictures of room completion and be featured on social media, in Arkansas Blue Cross' member magazine and in other media outlets
- Agreement to have the Calming Room completed by May 1, 2024
- Agreement to terms and conditions, which includes permission from your school's principal.
