

Diabetes Screening for People With Schizophrenia - Bipolar Disorder (SSD)

Description of Measure

The percentage of members 18–64 years of age with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder or bipolar disorder who were dispensed an antipsychotic medication and had a diabetes screening test during the measurement year.

Numerator Compliance

A glucose test or an HbA1c test performed during the measurement year.

Strategies for Success

- Communicate and coordinate care between primary care physicians and behavioral health providers by requesting or communicating test results
- Reach out to members who cancel appointments and assist with rescheduling as soon as possible
- Have standing orders for applicable tests annually for members diagnosed with schizophrenia or bipolar disorder.
- Assist member with coordination of care with appropriate referrals and scheduling
- Eligible ARHOME patients may request a kit for home testing of hemoglobin A1c. Interested patients may call **501-500-2184** to receive a kit delivered by mail at no charge.
